

# Keyworth U3A – Listening to Music Programme for April to August 2014

Our sessions are held in the Centenary Lounge on alternate Wednesday afternoons. We sign in from 2 p.m. to be ready for a 2.15 start, and finish at 4.00. We ask for a donation of £1 at each session to cover the cost of hiring the room. All Keyworth U3A members are very welcome to join us.

- 9 April**      **Music for the Piano:** including works by Beethoven, Chopin and Prokofiev, introduced by Alan Spooner.
- 23 April      From 2 to 8 Not a marathon session, but music for small groups, introduced by Bill Cooper.
- 7 May      The Overture Peter Stafford introduces examples of this popular form.
- 21 May**      **With the Composer's Compliments** – Alan Spooner plays music written for or dedicated to a particular person for a particular reason.
- 4 June      Members' choice: bring along a CD with a track or tracks you would like to share, or just come and listen - these sessions are always very entertaining.
- 18 June      These we have missed: Bill Cooper introduces music that has not so far featured in our programmes.
- 2 July      Woodwind windup: following his sessions on each individual member of the woodwind family Robin Stocker gives an overall view of their place in the orchestra.
- 16 July      Proms preview: John Stuckey looks at the 2014 programme and highlights concerts that appeal.
- 30 July      The Violin: Bill Cooper begins a series on stringed instruments of the orchestra with its most prominent member.
- 13 August**      **Nottingham Classics:** Alan Spooner previews the 2014/15 season.
