STRATFORD-UPON-AVON AND ANNE HATHAWAY'S COTTAGE, THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 27TH.

Depart by coach from Elm Avenue/Selby Lane at 9.00 am to travel to Stratford-upon-Avon. We will leave from Anne Hathaway's Cottage at 4.00 pm. There will be free time in Stratford. Set on the banks of the River Avon, Stratford-upon-Avon is best known for being the birthplace of William Shakespeare. This historic town has many local attractions including the house where Shakespeare was born, Shakespeare's New Place, the site of his family home for 19 years until his death and the Holy Trinity Church where Shakespeare and his wife Anne Hathaway are buried. We will leave Stratford at 1.30 pm for a short drive to Anne Hathaway's cottage. After an introductory talk you will free to look around the 600 year old cottage where Shakespeare courted his bride-to-be.
