

Short Walk – May 2018

Tuesday 15 May

This month's short walk will be Rushcliffe Country Park, Off Loughborough Road (A60), Ruddington NG11 6LS

We shall be setting off from the Village Hall car part at 10.30am and we will be having lunch at the Ruddington Arms after the walk.

The start of the walk will be in the car park at Rushcliffe County Park

The length of the walk is around 2 miles, about 1hour 15 mins – the walk can be extended if everyone feels they would like to do more on the day. Alternatively there are plenty of options for a shorter walk, which can be discussed when we meet at the car park. There are a number of benches along the route in case we need a rest!

During the walk we will be visiting the lake and the new orchard area and there should be plenty of wild flowers to see throughout the walk.

Most of the walk is on good paths, but there are a few grass paths by the orchard which could be wet with muddy patches if it has rained recently.

Directions to Rushcliffe Country Park from Keyworth

From the Village Hall car park, turn right onto Selby Lane.

At the T junction turn right and take the first left onto Bunny Lane. At the end of Bunny Lane turn right and continue on, passing Cherry Lane Garden Centre on your right.

At the T junction with the Loughborough Road (A60) turn right and continue on through Bradmore.

At the roundabout turn left onto the industrial estate.

At the next roundabout turn right and follow the access road round to the left and into the car park.

Please note there is a car park charge of £1.00 for all day.

Directions to the Ruddington Arms

Turn left at the roundabout at the park entrance.

At next roundabout turn left

At traffic lights turn left, Kirk Lane towards Ruddington Centre.

At T junction turn right – pub is on the right after the shops.
